AAA/CASA Annual Meeting – Nov. 15-19, Toronto, ON, CA

Right to Reproduce Information

By submitting your proposal to be considered for the Annual Meeting program, you are granting the American Anthropological Association (AAA) and the Canadian Anthropology Society (CASCA) the right to reproduce the information you submit herein (title, author, keywords, abstracts) in any and all media. Further, you grant permission for the AAA/CASCA to make your submission, and its presentation available across any of the Annual Meeting's platforms (in-person, or streamed into the virtual platform).

We highly recommend presenters sign up for an ORCID ID (if they do not already have one) and upload their work to the [Open Anthropology Research Repository](#) so their work can be assigned the appropriate Digital Object Identifier (DOI) which is tied to their ORCID ID, to prevent plagiarism. This service is entirely free and helps protect against misuse of presenters' work.

Refund Policy

Annual Meeting registration and AAA/CASCA membership is NOT required for all participants at the time of submission. Participants who are accepted onto the program (announced the week of July 5, 2023) will be required to register for the meeting and join/renew their membership with the AAA in order to appear on the program and present in their session.

Prior to July 5, 2023 proposals may be withdrawn by sending an email to aaameetings@americananthro.org (this link opens a new window).

To whom does this Cancellation and Refund Policy apply? This Cancellation and Refund Policy applies to all proposal participants (organizers, chairs, presenters, discussants, etc.). Refunds will not be granted for anyone appearing on the Annual Meeting program. For all others, **requests for refunds or cancellations must be made in writing and must be received by 11:59 PM ET October 6, 2023.**

Badge sharing, splitting, and reprints are strictly prohibited. If you register as a non-member with a Guest Presenter Registration (formerly a membership exemption) and decide to join AAA, the registration conversion may be accommodated within 30 days of the original transaction.
